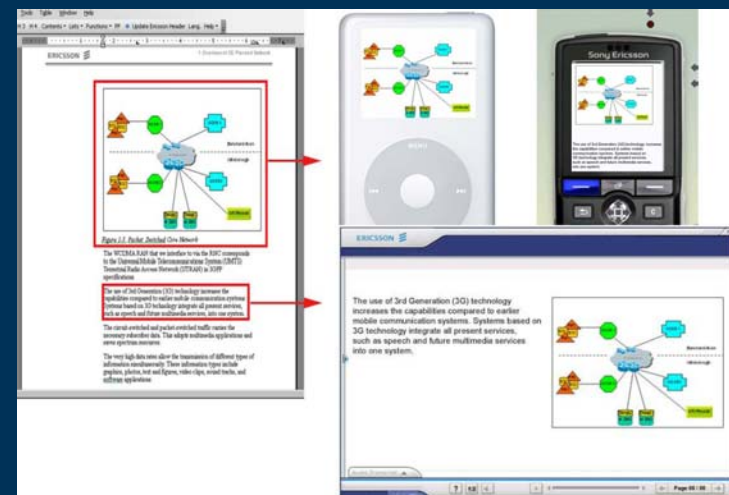
What have we now

- Rapid development of mobile learning content
- Simplification of development process

Pedagogy

- SME can develop rather than program developers
- Pedagogy informed by basic principles of constructivism
- Emergent theory connectivism (George Siemens)



Richer learning experience

- Audio, text, graphics and limited animation
- Mobile broadband, flexible data plans
- Media rich content development
 - Video
 - Collaboration tools
 - Group discussion



Mobile learning 2.0

- Context sensitive, location based training
- JIT (Just in time) or OTJ (on the job training)
- Technologies are in place but need to be bundled such as
 - RFID
 - GPS
 - SCORM
 - mLMS
 - Mobile Broadband
