

Assurance Report

To the readers of the **Ericsson Corporate Responsibility Report 2006**

At the request of management of Telefonaktiebolaget LM Ericsson, we have reviewed two performance indicators presented in graphs in the Ericsson Corporate Responsibility Report 2006:

- Results of Ericsson's supplier reviews presented under the heading "RESULTS OF RISK-BASED PROJECTS, 2006" on page 14, and
- Results of improvements in energy efficiency of radio base stations presented under the heading "AVERAGE RADIO BASE STATION ENERGY CONSUMPTION" on page 25

Sustainability and the reporting thereon is the responsibility of the Company's management. Ericsson's Corporate Responsibility department has the specific responsibility for the collection of information and the compilation of the results in the Corporate Responsibility Report. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these two indicators mentioned above based on our review.

We conducted our review in accordance with the International Standard on Assurance Engagements (ISAE) 3000. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain limited assurance whether the indicators are free of material misstatements. Our review has included the following work:

- Inquires of company personnel to obtain information regarding the performance indicators.
- Review of the principles for calculation and disclosure of the results of the performance indicators.
- Review of underlying documentation, on a test basis, to assess whether the information regarding the performance indicators, has been appropriately collected.

The work carried out by us provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and, accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Based on our work described in this report, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the indicators, mentioned above, have not, in all material aspects, been prepared in accordance with the criteria stated by Ericsson in this report.
