### **Statement on SAR information to consumers**

All Ericsson phone models are carefully designed and tested to comply with relevant safety standards and government regulations regarding radio frequency (RF) exposure. These worldwide standards take into account wide safety margins. Extensive research over the course of many years has not established any conclusive evidence of a link between adverse health effects and the use of mobile phones meeting those standards and regulations.

Ericsson and other manufacturers have been working hard to continue enhancing the types of health and safety information that are available to consumers and, specifically, to provide detailed information about the Specific Absorption Rate (SAR) for each new phone model.

All new Sony Ericsson phone models on the market have easy-to-read and up-to-date SAR information in the packaging, including the maximum SAR value.
