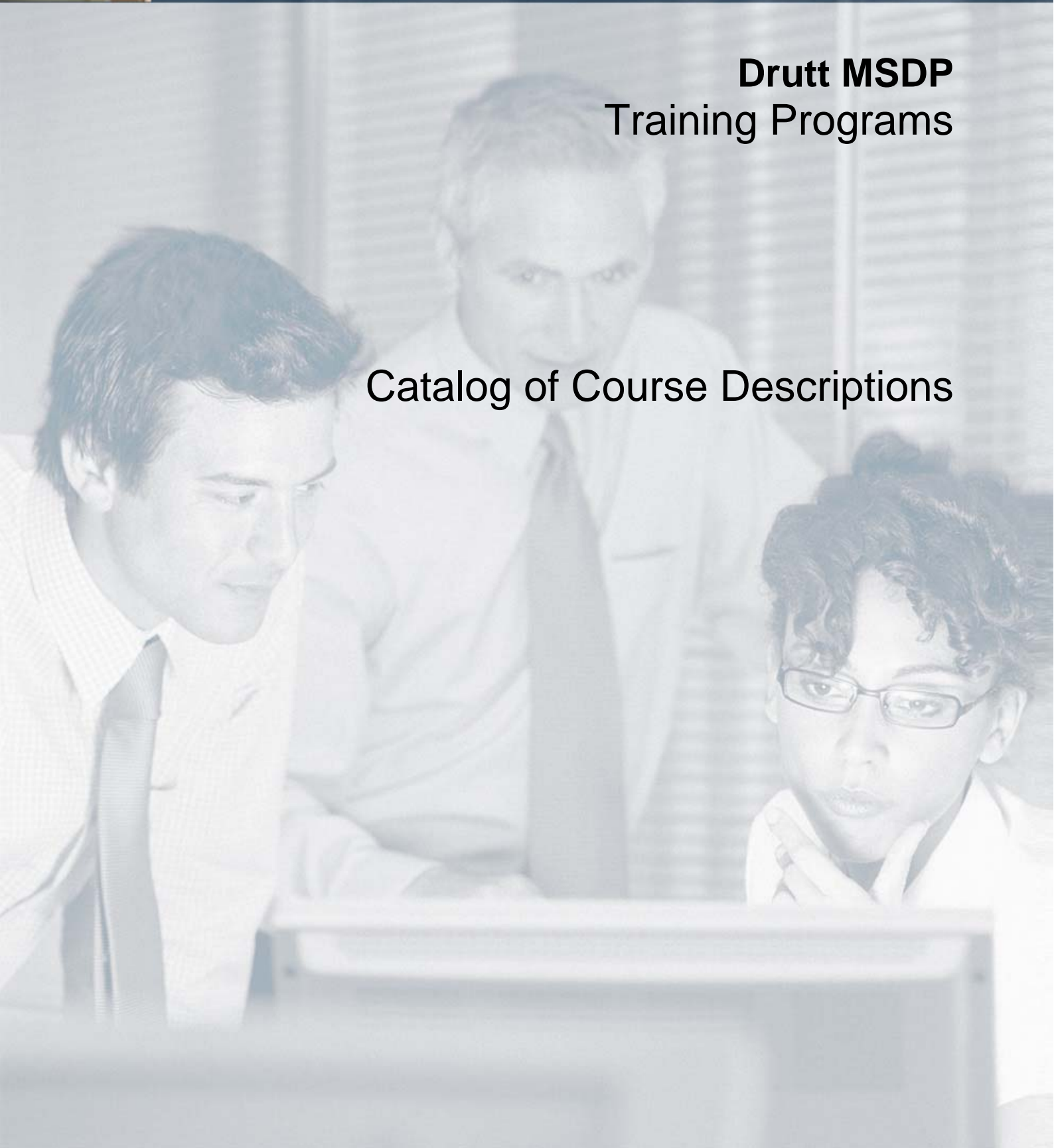

### Description
