Present Development of the Ericsson-Concern.

Already in the historical retrospect, published in Vol. I, Nos 1 & 2 of The L. M. Ericsson Review, it was stated that Telefonaktiebolaget L. M. Ericsson had been formed by the amalgamation of the various private Swedish telephone interests. From the very beginning these interests embodied the three main groups within the field of telephony, i. e. manufacture, erection and operation, and were represented by the two companies L. M. Ericsson & Co. and Stockholms Allmänna Telefonaktiebolag (The General Telephone Co. of Stockholm). Although entirely independent of each other from both a financial and administrative point of view, these two companies had supported and complemented each other, thus advancing a common cause. Also, the difference in age of these two companies, by whom the foundation for the present Ericsson organization was laid, is not large, the first mentioned having been established in 1876 and therefore as old as the telephone itself, and the latter in 1883, almost immediately after the telephone had attained such a state of development as to make it an efficiently useful article in the service of mankind. Some years later, after these two companies had acquired excellent reputations in the field of telephony through efficient and conscientious labour, the need for

expansion outside of the comparatively small field of activity in Sweden made itself seriously felt. Thus it came about that both L. M. Ericsson & Co. — in the capacity of a manufacturing companies — and Stockholms Allmänna Telefonaktiebolag — in the capacity of a building and operating enterprise — let their activities extend out beyond the bounds of their own country. This gave rise to a whole succession of foreign subsidiaries and agencies. The phenomenal development of this means of communication together with increasing competition in the world market finally resulted in the consolidation of the Swedish telephone concerns which up to this time and for almost forty years had stood side by side in their onward march to success.

Consequently, the Ericsson company is occupied with all the various groups of activity pertaining to applied lowtension electricity, i. e. *manufacture, erection and operation*, forming — together with its subsidiaries and agencies — a net — work which extends over the greater part of the earth.

The present development of the Ericsson concern is illustrated by the accompanying map of the world, a comprehensive list of all cooperating companies and agencies being given here below.

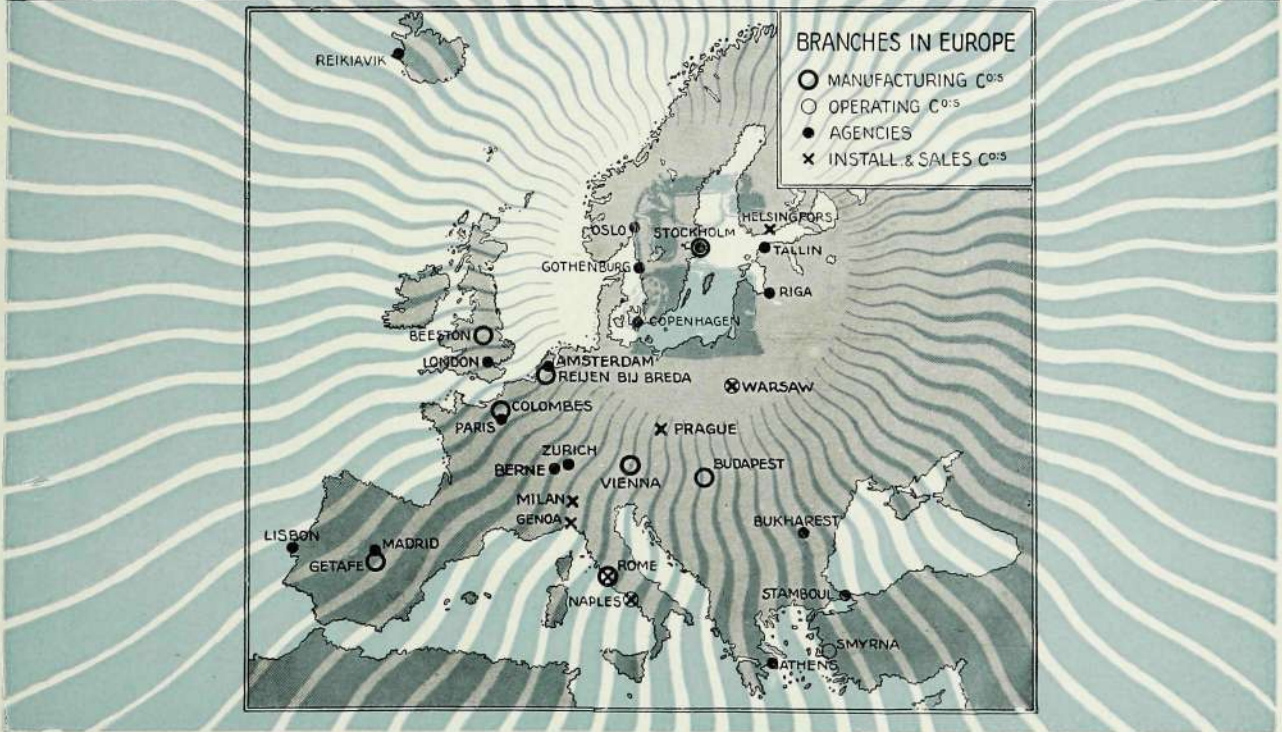
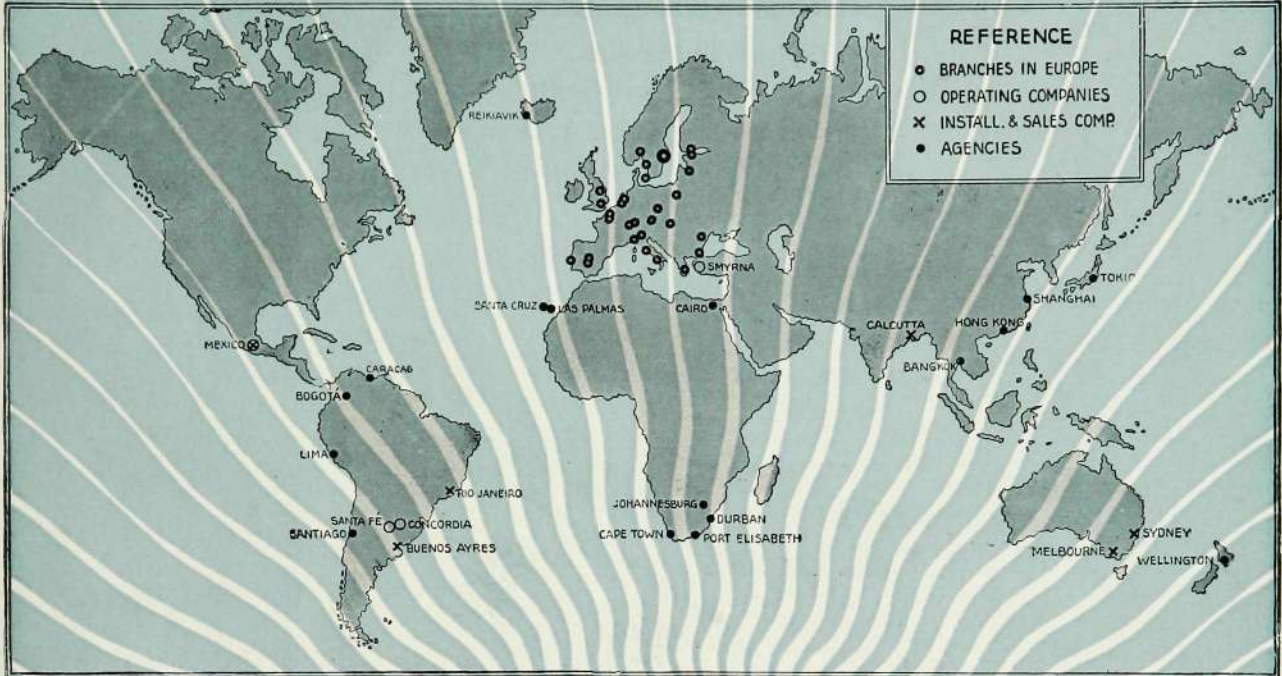

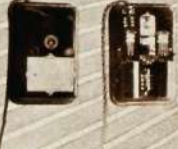
