1 Scope

The purpose of this document is to provide information on correct sorting for recycling of packaging materials used for products delivered by Ericsson. It covers primary, secondary and tertiary packaging used for Ericsson products. These are Ericsson designed products where the Ericsson logo is used on packaging. The neutral packaging list also applies to third-party products supplied by Ericsson.

2 Individual product packagings

Examples of Ericsson product packages



Packaging material used in standard product packaging	Example	Recycling symbol
Corrugated board Boxes, bottoms/sleeves/lids and similar Most components are marked with the new requirements. Old stock items may have older markings consisting of the recycling triangle without material code or "PAP" text		















<p>Foams – moulded EPP</p> <p>Used for fitments. Black or white with a granular structure. Are marked with the required symbols in the moulding process.</p>		
<p>Foams – EPE</p> <p>Used for fitments. White or black foam. Made from cut foam sheets glued/welded together. Are marked by printing</p>		
<p>Wood and plywood</p> <p>Used for pallets, battery boxes and crates for very heavy products. Old stock is not marked</p>	 	
<p>Plastic bags – PE</p> <p>Occasionally used for extra product protection or for moisture sensitive products. Old stock may not be marked</p>		
<p>EMC shielded bags – PE</p> <p>Used only for ESD sensitive product such as electronic components and printed board assemblies. Pink or silver plastic bags. Old stock may not be marked</p>		

















3 Neutral packaging - difficult to mark materials

Neutral packaging materials are “unprinted packaging featuring no graphics, symbols or information, sold as is by producers to customers”. Most of this material is either difficult to mark or sold unmarked as bulk material.

Packaging Material	Example	Recycling symbol
Fiber board (corner profiles and edge board) Sometimes used to protect and strengthen full pallet loads and to strengthen individual packing sets		
Paper Sometimes used to separate layers in pallet load		
Foams – PUR Used as filling material in pick from stock boxes		
Adhesive tape – PP Used to seal boxes, etc., and to ensure wetting protection		
Packing straps – PE Used to secure full pallet loads and some heavier product packagings		
Packing straps – PET Used to secure full pallet loads and some heavier product packagings		



<p>Stretch wrap – PE</p> <p>Used to secure full pallet loads and provide water resistance</p>		
<p>Protective plastic sheets – PE</p> <p>Occasionally used for extra product or package protection</p>		
<p>Protective plastic foam sheets – PE</p> <p>Occasionally used to provide surface protection</p>		
<p>Air filled cushions – PE (filling material)</p> <p>Used as filling material in pick from stock boxes</p>		
<p>Bubble wrap – PE</p> <p>Used as filling material in pick from stock boxes and for one off product protection, e.g. for spare parts</p>		
<p>Cable ties – PA</p> <p>Used to secure longer lengths of cable</p>		
<p>Protective caps – PE</p> <p>Used on sensitive connectors for dust and damage protection</p>
