Teamwork

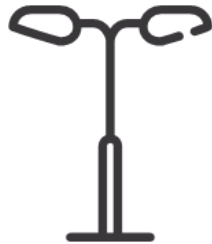
Think about a time you contributed to a team. Then, share with your group. Below, write down your team member names and something you learned about how they can contribute.

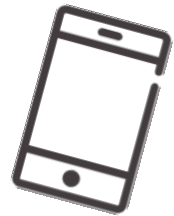
Skill 2 Activity: Brainstorming

Skill 4 Activity: Look for ways to make things better

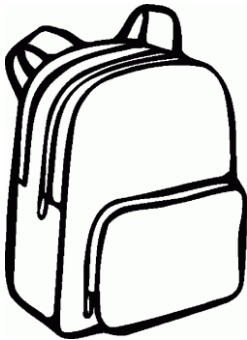
Based on the photo in the slide, what do you see? How can you make life better for people who live in this place?

Who are you solving this problem for?

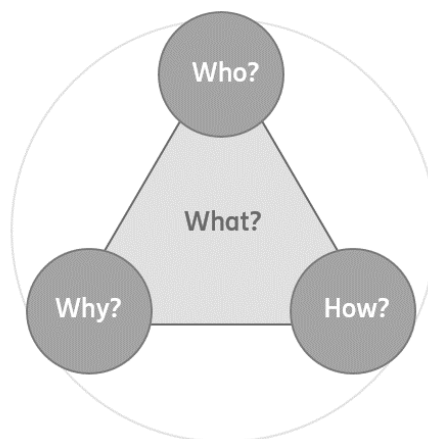
Step 3: Solution
